





# Violent Crime Rate 2014 – 2018










# *Custodial Arrests 2014 - 2018*


# Robbery (2018)

**Robberies increased from 36 in 2017 to 44 in 2018**




# Aggravated Assault (2018)

- Aggravated Assaults remained the same, 16 in both 2017 and 2018
- 37.5% family violence  
18.8% road rage




# Burglary (2018)

- **Burglaries increased from 159 in 2017 to 186 in 2018**
- **69% of burglaries were in residential areas**
- **Residential Burglary increased 27 cases from 2017 to 2018**




## Theft (2018) with BMV Removed

- **Thefts increased 197 cases from 2017 to 2018 (28.6%).**
- **Shoplifting accounts for 34.2% of the thefts.**




## BMV (2018)






# Traffic Safety




# Number of Traffic Stops








