Holiday Solid Waste & Recycle Collection Schedule (Not applicable for Greatwood)

Solid Waste and Recycling collection for all areas will not occur on New Year's, Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday. For all areas, except Greatwood, if the collection day falls on one of the three specified holidays, residents will receive service the following day. All other holidays will maintain the regular collection schedule.

Cooking Oil and Grease

Used cooking oil and cooking grease can be dropped off at the Recycling Center located at Public Works, 111 Gillingham Lane. The center is open Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Please check in at the front office.

Bulk Cardboard Recycling

Bulk cardboard recycling is offered on an on-call basis. This service is only for quantities of cardboard that are too large to fit in the recycle cart. Styrofoam, packing materials and any other items are not accepted. Flatten boxes.
