

Solid Waste Holiday Service Schedule 2020

For 2020, Greatwood residents will follow the holiday collection schedule for Christmas and New Year's Day ONLY

Solid Waste and recycling collection will not occur on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's holidays. If your collection day falls on one of the three specified holidays, you will receive service the following day. All other holidays will maintain the regular collection schedule.

Bulky Waste

The City provides an additional bulky waste collection following Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.

Bulk Cardboard Recycling

Republic Services provides bulk cardboard recycling on an on-call basis. This service is only for quantities of cardboard that are too large to fit in the recycle cart. Boxes should be flattened and all Styrofoam and packing materials must be removed. To schedule a pick-up, contact Republic Services at SugarLand@RepublicServices.com or 713-726-7307.

Electronic Recycling

Republic Services will provide electronics recycling on an on-call basis, as part of the Household Hazardous Waste program, until December 31, 2020. This service is for electronics such as TVs, computers, monitors, and similar electronic waste. To properly dispose of your electronic waste, please contact Republic Services at SugarLand@RepublicServices.com or 713-726-7307.

Effective January 1, 2021, the on-call Household Hazardous Waste program will no longer be available. Residents can utilize the Fort Bend County Recycling Center to dispose of electronics and other household hazardous wastes. Christmas Trees

Residents can place live Christmas trees out for collection on regular weekly green waste collection days. Ornaments, tinsel and lights must be removed for collection. Christmas trees should not be disposed of in City parks.

Artificial Christmas trees can be disposed of on a bulky waste collection day. Please ensure that trees are disassembled before placing at the curb for collection.

Textile Recycling

Textile recycling is provided once a week on your regularly scheduled recycle day. This program targets textiles going into landfills, not items being donated to charities, churches, non-profits, and other organizations. Residents should place items in an orange Simple Recycling bag and leave at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled recycle day.

Cooking Oil and Grease

Used cooking oil and cooking grease can be disposed of at the Public Works Service Center located at 101A Gillingham Lane. Residents can dispose of up to 10 gallons of liquid cooking oil per day at no charge. The facility is open Monday-Friday 8 a.m.-5 p.m. with the exception of the following holidays, November 26-27, 2020, December 24-25, 2020 and January 1, 2021, during which time the facility will be closed. Please be sure to check in at the front office.
