

HOW DO LPR CAMERAS WORK?

A crime occurs



When a crime occurs, a vehicle description such as make, model, color and license plate number become valuable information for investigators.

LPR cameras can be important forensic tools to help catch, arrest and convict criminals.

Suspect's vehicle on the move



The cameras record the outside of vehicles for the purpose of capturing license plates. Fixed LPR cameras are located at locations throughout the City to cover a specific area.

As the suspect's vehicle moves around the city, LPR cameras are capturing digital images of license plates and vehicle specifications. By policy, this information is kept for just 30 days before it's deleted.

Description added to LPR system



Authorized police personnel will access the system after a crime occurs to look for a suspect vehicle during the time period when a crime occurred.
