RECOMMENDED ACTION
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Authorize a construction contract in the amount of \$133,870.90 with Third Coast Services LLC for the re-installation of the street lights along U.S.90A.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On September 24, 2009, eight qualified bids were received for the construction of the project to re-install the 40-foot, decorative cobra head street lights along U.S. 90A. The low bidder was Third Coast Services LLC with a base bid of \$122,620.90. All bidders were requested to submit a price for extra work items in addition to the base bid. Third Coast bid \$11,250 for the extra work items bringing the total bid to \$133,870.90.

Though the City has not contracted with Third Coast in the past and they have been in business only since 2005, they are being recommended for award based on the positive reference checks which include responses from the TxDOT Fort Bend Area Office about their performance on three projects.

Construction is scheduled to begin in late October. The contract length is 100 calendar days though through conversations with the contractor it is anticipated that the project will be complete in less than 50. Coordination has taken place and will continue throughout the project between the Parks and the Public Works Departments to ensure that the lighting project does not negatively impact the ongoing landscape project.

Funding for this project is available in CIP No. ST0303 (U.S. 90A Widening) with a remaining balance of \$133,972.68. All costs associated with the design, pole purchase and construction of this project will be reimbursed by TxDOT when the work is complete. This is in accordance with the 1998 agreement between TxDOT and the City executed prior to the initial installation.

The Public Works Department recommends the City Council authorize the execution of a construction contract in the amount of \$133,870.90 with Third Coast Services for the re-installation of the street lights along U.S.90A.
