Period Covered: January 1st through December 31st, 2009

During this Period Internal Affairs Investigated:

- 3 Formal Complaints (those meeting requirements of Texas Government Code Chapter 614 concerning complaints against Police Officers)
- 0 Informal Complaints (those not meeting requirements of Texas Government Code Chapter 614 concerning complaints against Police Officers)
- Within the 3 total Complaints received there were 5 allegations of misconduct made
 - 1 [33%] concerned allegations of issues regarding Discourtesy
 - 1 [33%] concerned allegations of issues concerning procedure on notifying a Supervisory Officer
 - 1 [33%] concerned allegations of issues concerning Use of Excessive Force
- The 3 Formal Complaints resulted in
 - 1 finding of Policy Failure [The act the allegation was based on did occur; however existing Policy was not clear on the topic] Policy was revised.
 - 2 findings of Sustained [Misconduct Occurred]. Employee disciplined.
- Internal Affairs received and filed 11 Class IV Allegations (an allegation determined by a Supervisor to be based upon a citizen's misunderstandings of the law, established lawful procedures, or appropriate investigative techniques / or where immediate and conclusive evidence shows the allegation(s) to be baseless)
- Internal Affairs did 1 Special Investigation into an officer involved shooting with the determination that force was justified / no policy violation.
