## RECREATIONAL DISC GOLF RULES

**OBJECTIVE:** One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins.

**SAFETY FIRST:** Never throw when players or park users are within range. Always give park users the right of way. Be aware of your surroundings and environment.

**TEE THROWS:** Each hole begins with a tee throw. A player must be within or behind the designated tee area when the disc is released.

**THROWING ORDER:** The player with the least number of strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the basket always throws first.

**LIE:** The lie is the spot where the player's previous throw has landed. Mark the lie with a mini disc in front of the thrown disc, or just leave the thrown disc down. A disc that comes to rest above the playing surface is marked directly below the disc.

**FAIRWAY THROWS:** Fairway throws must be made from directly behind the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed, unless the lie is within 10 meters (~33') of the basket.

**PUTTING:** Any shot within 10 meters of the basket is a putt. No contact beyond the lie is permitted, i.e., no follow-through. A player must demonstrate full control of balance before advancing past the lie.

**HOLE COMPLETION:** A disc that comes to rest inside the basket or chains constitutes successful completion of that hole. A disc resting on top of the basket does not count.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** If any area of OB is visible between the disc and OB line, then the disc is considered OB. A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from a point 1 meter (~39") in bounds from where the disc went OB, or from the previous lie.

## SPECIFIC RULES FOR THIS COURSE:

Completely on or across any concrete path from the basket is OB except for the path section between #2's tee pad and basket.

## COURSE COURTESY:


- Remain quiet and avoid unnecessary movements while others are throwing.
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until throwing is complete.
- Remove the disc from basket after completing the hole.
- Help new players learn the rules.
  - Allow faster groups to play through when possible.
  - Pick up trash and put in proper receptacles.
  - Do not alter the course (trees, bushes, etc.) in any way.
