



NOTICE OF FORT BEND MUD NO. 269 WELL DRILLING APPLICATION PUBLIC HEARING

Fort Bend Municipal Utility District No. 269 has submitted a well drilling application under the City's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 3, Article X, Sec. 3-176.

The proposed well will serve as a temporary groundwater source to fill an amenity lake while the reclaimed facility is under construction. The City recommends the application to drill the well be approved by council in order to comply with the terms of Chapter 3, Article X – Drilling of Wells.

A public hearing on the **authorization of the Fort Bend Municipal Utility District No. 269 Well Drilling Permit Application has been scheduled for March, 17 at 5:30 p.m.** at Sugar Land City Hall, 2700 Town Center Blvd. N., Sugar Land, Texas 77479. The well owner, will be required to drill the well to the specifications outlined on the application form, comply with standards listed in the City's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 3-176(b), and upon completion of the new reclaimed facility the well will become a backup supply with reclaimed being the primary source to fill the amenity lake.
