- Best E-gov Services, by MuniNetGuide.com, an online guide and directory to Web sites for state, county and local government.
- Best Place to Live: Money Magazine ranked Sugar Land 17th among its hottest places to live in America. The magazine started with statistics on 271 U.S. cities provided by OnBoard LLC, a real estate information company. These cities had the highest median household incomes in the nation and above average population growth.
- The Texas Court Clerks Association (TCCA) has selected Janell Kucera, Sugar Land Municipal Court administrator, for the Award of Excellence.
