On Dec. 10, 1913, the Brazos River flooded all the way to Sugar Land. This was not an unusual occurrence. Flood water contributed to health concerns and unwanted wildlife. Levees completed during the early 20s and the dredging of Oyster Creek corrected the problem. Levees continue to play an important role in the rapid, successful development of Sugar Land.
